## Vapor Recovery Deadline

The EPA has put out a flyer called "*Summary of Regulations Controlling Air Emissions from Gasoline Dispensing Facilities (GDF)*". It has the information most facilities need to know for compliance, which facilities need to have it, what reporting and documentation you need to be doing, and most important is the deadline. For existing sites (built before November 9, 2006) that will fall under the requirements the deadline is January 10, 2011. For sites built after November 9, 2006 you should currently be in compliance. You can get this flier on our website [tankmgmt.net](http://tankmgmt.net). On the right click on UST's and AST's.
